INTRODUCTION

The Company provides outsourcing services for small and medium business in the field of temporary personnel, services for documentary flow and payments to remove contractors payments through Payment Providers and organized automatic document flow.

CONDITIONS FOR USING A SIMPLE ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE

These Rules establish the procedure for using a simple electronic signature by any Users when they work in their Personal account located on the site www.euro-status.com (hereinafter-the Site).

A simple electronic signature is an electronic signature that, by the use of the user code (ID) confirms the formation of an electronic signature specific user.

The key is a combination of 2 elements-the key ID and password. Next password can be changed by the User when entering their email address, the first-time access to your personal account. The key password is a sequence of characters created by the user that the User chooses after the first access to the personal account.

The user has the right to create (replace) a password.

The generated key password must contain at least the number of required characters.

The key is created (replaced) and issued free of charge.

Users are required to ensure the confidentiality of the key:

- keep the key secret and take all possible measures to prevent its violation privacies;
- generate a simple electronic signature using the key obtained in the order, established by these Rules;
- if the key is violated or lost, replace it immediately key.

A simple electronic signature generated by the User used in the Database, is the owner of the key, which is equivalent to the handwritten signature of this User's. Electronic documents generated by the User in the database with using the key, are recognized as equivalent to documents signed with your own hand the User's signature.

Verifying the authenticity of a simple electronic signature that is used to sign a request or an electronic document that is implemented by the Site's functionality.

A person whose right has been violated has the right to apply personally to the Site Administration with a statement on the fact that a simple electronic signature of the specified person was used by an improper person for restoration of the violated right in person.

If the User contacts the site Administration cancels the password simple electronic signature within one day from the date of receipt of the specified application.
